Courses and Learning Agreement:

Dear incomings students,

Before your arrival here, you need to complete what we call a "Learning Agreement" between your university and our university. The list of courses in English is found at http://www.hs-koblenz.de/rac-english

You can click on each course to read its syllabus.

There are prescribed courses for all exchange students, already included in the Learning Agreement (*Table A Before the mobility*) you will receive via Email, and you can add more courses from the list. These courses will boost your employability in international contexts while allowing you to reflect and add value to your international experience at RheinAhrCampus.

4 Prescribed courses for the Summer Semester (March to August)

- B002 Competence in German
- B261 Intercultural Communication

5 Prescribed courses for the Winter Semester (September to February)

- B258 International Studies I
- B002 Competence in German
- B003 Managing Cultural Diversity
- B261 Intercultural Communication

Please note that we require students to take a minimum of 30 ECTS.

If you have enough German language proficiency, you can take any course from our course catalogue: http://www.myrac.de/syllabus. In this case, you don't have to take the course Competence in German, as your German would have already been good enough to take courses in German. If you are unsure about your level of German, you may also take a digital German Language Placement Test for Exchange Students prior to your arrival. We will create an OpenOLAT account for you if needed.

Erasmus Learning Agreement:

1. To be submitted BEFORE arrival

Page 1 - Table A Before the mobility

Please enter your choice of course in the Learning Agreement, Table A Before the mobility. Send the Learning Agreement signed by you and your supervisor to the coordinator at RheinAhrCampus and you will receive the version signed by RheinAhrCampus.

Please submit the signed version by all three parties of Table A - BEFORE THE MOBILITY.

2. Course changes to be submitted DURING the Mobility at RheinAhrCampus

Page 2 - Table A2 During the mobility: Exceptional changes to Table A

During your Erasmus Mobility, changes to the Learning Agreement might be necessary after reviewing the Timetable on MyStudy Portal of RheinAhrCampus.

Each Erasmus exchange student will have and individual consultation meeting with the coordinator at RheinAhrCampus during the Orientation Week and changes can be made to the Learning Agreement if needed.

A signed copy of the changes - Page 2 - Table A2 During the mobility: Exceptional changes to Table A – will be sent to the home university.

3. Submission AFTER the Erasmus Stay

Transcript of Records by RheinAhrCampus

At the end of the Semester the Transcript of Records will be issued by the Coordinator in Sprachen/Internationales with all the courses and grades included in the Learning Agreement considering the changes to the Learning Agreement during the Mobility. The Transcript of records will be sent to the home University and the student will also receive a copy of the Transcript of records.
