What does the library at the RheinAhrCampus offer?

- Literature in printed and digital form, which can be found with several research instruments:
 - o **Books** (approx. 60.000) and **eBooks** (approx. 100.000) → Research in the Discovery System PRIMO
 - Journals (approx. 200) and eJournals (approx. 3.200) → Research in the Discovery System PRIMO and in the Elektronischen Zeitschriftenbibliothek (EZB)
 - **Articles** from scientific journals & more → in the Discovery System PRIMO or in specialist databases (over 25 licensed across the campus and countless more for free in the internet) through the <u>Datenbank-Infosystem (DBIS)</u>
 - Newspaper and ePaper (e.g. Frankfurter Allgemeine Zeitung, The New York Times,...) → Research through the homepage of the library

- Order of more literature from libraries all across Germany (Fernleihe)
- Courses (in person & online) about the usage of the library, literature research & organisation, additional provision of courses on the learning platform <u>OLAT</u>
- Possiblities to copy, print & scan
- Several workstation with and without PC

Why do I need a library account and how do I get one?

- → to use the Open Library, to loan and reserve books and to prolong a loaning period
- → E-Mail <u>ausleihe@rheinahrcampus.de</u> with an <u>Anmeldeformular</u>, scans of the frontside and back of your ID and your student card attached or in person

What kind of literature can I borrow/use for how long?

- Books: 4 weeks; renewals of four weeks for up to five times
 - At earliest three days before the loaning period ends & only if there are no reservations on the book → Overdue charge when overextending the loan period are: 2,00€ per book + week
- **eBooks**: depends on the provider; there is usually a timely unlimited download possible sometimes the download has to be refreshed after a week
- Journal issues and -volumes: not for loaning

How do I access the electronic offers? (eBooks, eJournals & databases)

- Access from the campus / with the university network without issue
- Access from outside with a VPN connection
