The programme structure

The Bachelor of Arts: Social Work programme is a modularised full-time programme. A module is a self-contained course unit in terms of content and time. It is awarded credits according to the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS) and is completed by examinations during the course of study.

The programme is divided into 7 study areas, the project workshops, the theory-practice units and the Bachelor's thesis. The study programme is made up of compulsory, compulsory elective and specialisation modules. Students complete an average of 18 semester hours (SWS) per semester and week in contact studies. In addition, there is the time that may be required for the preparation and follow-up of the individual courses, in-depth self-study and the preparation and execution of examinations. Students earn 30 credits (ECTS) per semester, which corresponds to 900 hours of workload.

The thematic orientation

The Bachelor of Arts: Social Work programme at Koblenz University of Applied Sciences, Faculty of Social Sciences, provides students with a practice-oriented education on a social science basis, leading to a first university degree with professional qualifications in a consecutive Bachelor - Master programme.

Students acquire professional competences to implement current findings in social work in a solution-oriented manner.

Through modern learning methods, the use of new media, interdisciplinary curricular learning units and personal contact with the lecturers, students are prepared for the requirements in the fields of action and tasks of social work. They learn to process social work issues in different fields of work independently, in a decision-oriented and action-competent manner. A close, efficient link between theory and practice and international references are the hallmarks of the programme. The department maintains excellent contacts with the regional institutions of the voluntary and public sector and other actors in the field of social work, and is involved in nationwide and international networks in many ways through its teachers.
