Course Outline

- **Objectives:** The course mainly focuses on the needs of students who need to take the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL®). It aims to introduce students to the basic structure of the test and show them ways of preparing for this situation. Special emphasis will be placed on the grammatical skills required for the successful completion of the "Structure and Written Expression" section of the test.
- **Contents:** Preparation for the Test of English as a Foreign Language.
- **Require**ments: Successful completion of Business English I recommended. Students should have strong listening and reading skills and a good sense of grammar.
- **Teaching method:** After an initial diagnostic test, which will indicate the specific needs of the individual members of the group, a learning programme will be arranged. Students will be encouraged to use our library resources and our language lab resources in order to deal with their individual problems. Inclass activities will focus on test-taking and preparation strategies, selected fields of syntax, and comprehension skills. A number of useful skillbuilding exercises will be provided. Students are expected to do a good deal of individual work beyond the in-class activities.
- Assessment: Throughout the semester, students will take part in a number of multiplechoice tests which will help them to get used to the TOEFL format.
